P/61 Alger - spoken Auger - a West of Eng. surname.

1. Andrew b. 1610. The Alger brothers (bro. Arthur) named their Indian purchase in Scarborough, Dunstan for Dunstone in the parish of Yealmpton, Devon. Andrew came with Winter & after his time was out became a fishing master himself, having his house at Prout's neck, Cleeve in 1643 called him "of Stratton's Id." a name for Scarborough. He had a grant in Saco before Mass. came in, but led a company to withdraw to Dunstan, Jurymen, constable, selectman - ~~mayor~~ surveyor. Will - made 23 Mar. 1669-70. Proved at Salem 30 June 1676 by wid. Agnes (b. 1621). Andrew was killed abt 10 Oct. 1675. ch: ① John b. 1640-1 - of Boston innholder - m. Mary Wilmot dau. of
