He would be too young to be a son of Peter de Wyckhurst, but the right age to be a grandson, He was probably named after his grandfather, and is likely the son of William above, since there is a William with wife Juliana living in this vicinity in 1318, probably the son of Peter above, who in turn was probably named after his own grandfather, the above William, yeoman of 1278.
