	9	NOTE: Since no probate record or similar type record has been found for John, the father above, it has been difficult to establish this family. Several of the children are only presumed to belong to this group. There is little if any doubt concerning the parentage of Harman, John and Agnes, children no. 2,3, and 5. Abigail Atwood Shurtleff, great gd dau. of John, child no. 3, she herself born 1755, made a statement to the effect that John had two brothers Stephen and William. John, Stephen and Henry were closely associated in the Plymouth Colony, having land adjoining each other, and by their actions indicating a close relationship. Johanna, child no. 1, is known to be a child of a John Atwood, and since the above father is the only John Atwood known to have been in this parish at that time, it is assumed she was his first child.
