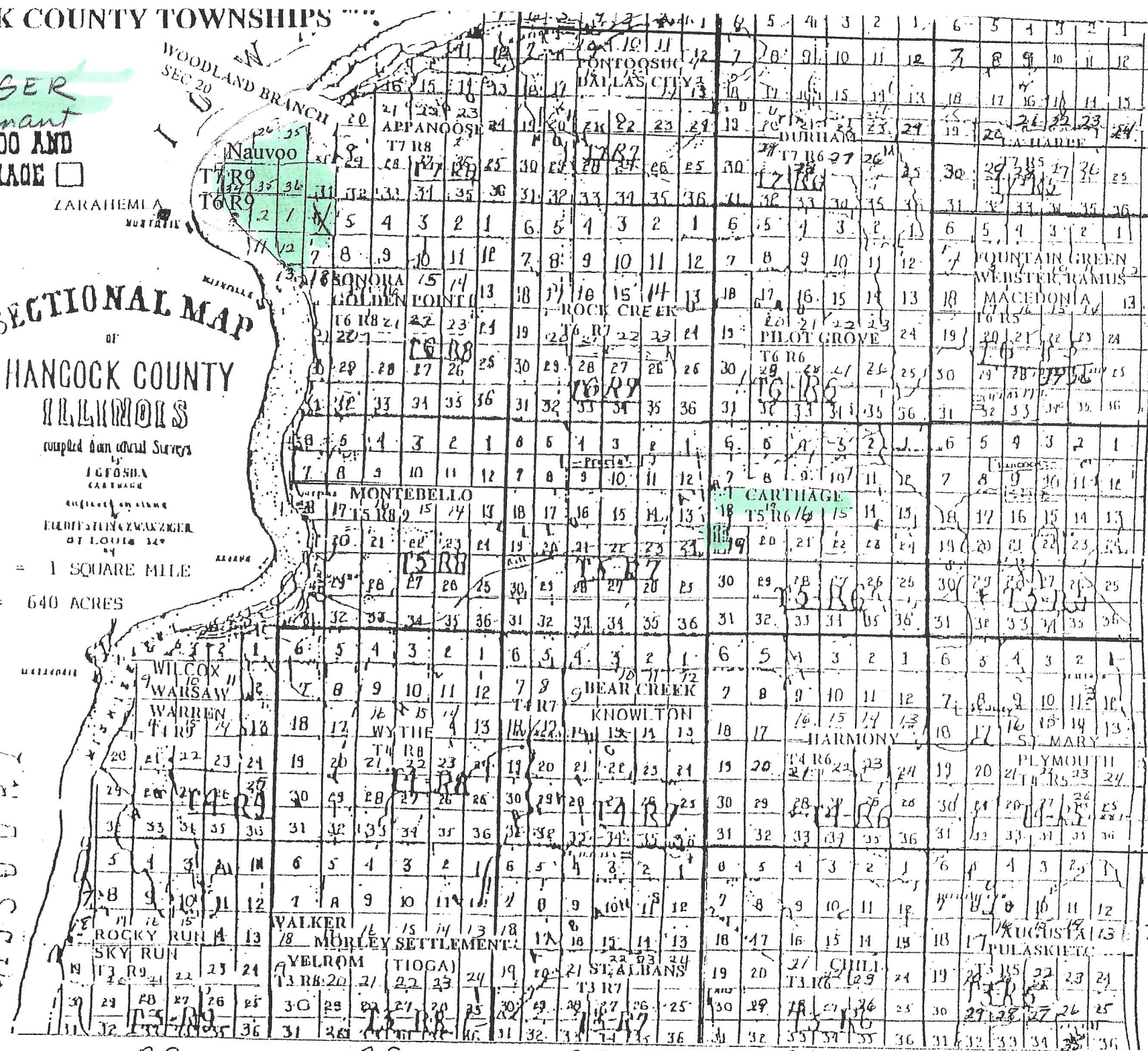

 High Council that same day. He covenanted to assist saints

in removing from Missouri.
