Dear Mr. Hall:

Reference is made to your letter of February 11, 1953, requesting information of a personal nature regarding William Ballinger, Sergeant, Virginia Continental Line, Revolutionary War.

Careful search of the Revolutionary War pension and bounty-land records of the Veterans' Administration in the National Archives has failed to reveal a file for William Ballinger. It is possible that The Adjutant General, Department of the Army, Washington 25, D. C., can furnish information concerning military service.

The records of the General Land Office in the National Archives show that Virginia Military Bounty Land Warrant 4443 for 200 acres was issued to William Ballinger on December 13, 1788, for his services for 3 years as a "Sergeant of the Continental Line." He did not use the warrant to obtain a Federal patent to land, but on March 21, 1792, assigned his rights and title in it unto George Thompson "for value received." On October 14, 1793, George Thompson reassigned the warrant unto Colonel Joseph Crockett who later assigned it unto John McKinney. The latter used it to locate 200 acres of land in Champaign County, Ohio (Virginia Military Patent Volume 11, page 29).

William Ballinger's bounty-land warrant file does not contain any information of a personal or family nature. For information concerning the "two hundred acres of land in Fairfax County, Virginia," it is suggested that you write to Department of Archives, Virginia State Library, Richmond, Virginia.
