None of the above sources indicate a child by that name in this family, but even if there were she could not have been the wife of Louis III, since he was born in 860 and died 22 years of age. It is not likely he would have married a woman some 45 to 50 years his senior. Even if she had been born right after her father's death she would still be 21 years older than Louis III.
