Arms. Sable, a star of eight points Or. between fanchues, Erm.

Arms of GEORGE ROBERT EARL OF BUCKINGHAMSHIRE, BARON HOBART, &c. Quarterly, HAMPDEN and HOBART, viz. 1 and 4 Arg. a saltire Gules between 4 eagles displayed Az. HAMPDEN, 2 and 3 HOBART, as above. Crests: On the dexter side, on a wreath, a talbot collared Gu. and with a string of the same tied thereto, and in a knot over the back. HAMPDEN. On the sinister, on a wreath, a bull per pale S. and Gu. Bezantè, a ring in his nose Or. Supporters, dexter, a stag regardant Proper, gorged radiant, and with its line or chain Or. Sinister, a talbot Proper, collared radiant, and with its chain Or. Motto, Vestigia nulla retrorsum: Auctor pretiosa facit.
