Dorothy Hall was born on Wednesday, Mar. 17, 1943 at 8:27 p.m. at the home of her parents at 8x15 E. 4. N. Springville Utah. She weighed 7 1/4 pounds and was 20 1/2 inches long. The doctor and nurse present were Dr. Glen G. Ostoy and Mrs. Millie R. Martain. She had her first tooth Aug 8. just before she was 5 mo. Dorothy had polio in July and because of that she didn't sit alone until she was a year old. She stood alone at 18 mo. and walked soon after. Entered school at the Grant grade school Sept. 1949. Went to the Brookside school for the fifth grade, also the sixth.

In Feb. 1955, Dorothy's back was operated on twice because of polio. She was in a cast until September. This same fall, she joined the High School orchestra and was given a violin by Rolfe Griffiths.
