

I was interviewed by bishop Sheron S. Hall, and Jesse H. Whiting Sun. 15 July 1948. They asked me if I would go on a mission to the Guni Hopi mission. I told them I had never had a desire to go on a mission but would go. I was examined by Dr. Orton Shuro.
22 July. The blood test came back 27 July.

I was interviewed by Elder Joseph F. Merrill in his office 4 Aug. 1948.

I received my call 12 Aug. to the northern states mission. I was disappointed but in my heart knew we are called where we are best qualified to go. This mission includes Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Iowa, Wisconsin, Michigan headquarters at Chicago.

I was inoculated for typhoid fever 26 Aug 1st time, 2nd. 2 Sept. 3rd. 10 Sept. vaccinated for small pox 10th Sept. by nurses in Dr. ^{Wilkens} J. Biesinger office.

Shirley had us there for dinner 2 Sept. Pearl for the evening 9th.
