Joseph Elwood Hall, 83

Retired Construction Worker Dies

SPRINGVILLE — Joseph Elwood Hall, 83, retired Springville construction worker, died early Monday morning at the family home following a long illness.

He was born Sept. 7, 1879, a son of Joseph and Sarah Terry Hall, and received his education in the Springville schools. He married Grace Mattley and was later divorced. He later married Bessie McDonald in the Salt Lake Temple and she died in 1935.

He was a member of the LDS Church. He had followed highway and railroad construction for most of his life and had worked for 10 years on the LDS Church welfare farm in Springville.

Surviving are one son and one daughter, Joseph Franklin Hall and Mrs. Joseph (Hazel) Hughes, both of Salt Lake City; seven grandchildren; 16 great-grandchildren; one brother and one sister, Theron S. Hall and Miss Eleanore Hall, both of Springville.

Funeral services will be conducted Wednesday at 1 p.m. in the Springville Fourth-Tenth LDS Ward Chapel with Bishop W. Verl Whiting of the Fourth Ward officiating.
