THE STONE HOUSE, 1833

Linus H. Hall is the present owner of the Hall Farm which has come down from father to son since the Founding of Wallingford, in 1670.

The house is the most recently-built of the dwellings on the farm, having been built in 1833, by Mr. Hall's grandfather, Nathan.

It has certain unique characteristics, one being four Aces, placed high on the southern exterior; another is a large sink hollowed out of a stone. This was probably made for the first dwelling-house on the place. The iron hooks on which beef was formerly hung to dry, are in the ceiling of the former kitchen, now used as a dining room.

A large rock used as a bird-bath, was hollowed out by the tongues of hundreds of cattle, licking up salt.




