Pioneer Graves To Get Marker
No longer need a pioneer Utah couple lie in unmarked graves.
Through the efforts of family members the graves of George William and Mary Astington Kirkham in Lehi City Cemetery are now marked with a suitable headstone.
Dedication ceremonies for the headstone will be conducted at 11 a. m., on Memorial Day, May 30, at Lehi Cemetery and the numerous descendants of this couple now residing in Lehi and Salt Lake City are invited to attend.

The brief graveside services will be conducted by Ebenezer J. Kirkham, and the oldest living descendant, Francis W. Kirkham, will dedicate the marker.
Time and the elements have deteriorated the original markers, family members said. Also a fire destroyed the cemetery records in 1898 leaving no records to indicate who lies in a grave if the burial took place prior to 1898.
