Brian P. settled at Watertown, Mass. Freeman in 1634
Sudbury. In 1646 was Capt of the Co. of artillery now
called the "Ancient & Honorable" abt 1650 moved to
Portsmouth N. H. Deputy to gen. Court from Watertown &
"Engaged in commerce & acquired a handsome
estate."

On side of Mass. in disputes with that Colony &
was appointed major or commander of the forces of
the Province in 1668.
