- 26:306: Nov. 27, 1799, David Prichard of Waterbury....fifty dollans.... to Jacob Hall of Sharon....land at Blakeslee field.... witnesses, Phinehas Porter, Ansel Porter.
- 27:46 Mar. 9, 1801, James Smith of Waterbury....Five Hundred Dollars....to Jacob Hall of Waterbury....one acre and bounded north on Capt. Samuel Juds land, David Baldwin, Jr....land bought of James Whitney with buildings.... witnesses, Samuel Brown, Jr., John Kingsbury.
