Henry de Hanbury, joined the Earls of Lancaster, Warwick and Hereford against the King, suffered imprisonment but was released through the efforts of his uncle John de Hanbury. He was finally pardoned in 1318 after which he seems to have risen in the good graces of the King as in 1326 he was appointed Lord Chief Justice of Common Pleas in Ireland.
