about 4 of the Elders put
on a Skit or dramatized
mistakes the Elders make
it really was cute.

Two of the Elders were the
husband & wife & the
other 2 were new
missionaries. Elder
Litchford who is about
6'6" dressed up like
the wife, using Sister
Bolster's skirt & sweater
& a sombrero worn
like the Brethren wear
them & we put ~~down~~
my hairpin on him.
All in all he looked
quite lovely. One of
the Elders sang in a
geatitt. They say
"Up Jeeley Roger" & Deep

River." It was just beautiful. Then Sister Balster concluded the program with a dramatic reading on our Pioneer Heritage.

It was very dramatic & done very well. She had worked hard on it & spent a hectic day Sat. morning & afternoon making a Pioneer costume.

July 25, 1966

Dakota was the conference with President Nixon.

I think it was one of the most inspiring days I've spent since

I left the Mission Home in fact letters

After the conference which lasted 7:00 p.m. we gone.

Umar the 2nd lesson.
I'm so tired.

July 26,

Today first thing we
got up went to the M.O.
to talk to President Nicker
about Sr. Brown. The
President said we just
were in a position to
forgive him of the murders
he had committed & if he
entered into the waters
of baptism that is what
we would be doing.
Sister Balster was pretty
upset about the prospect of
telling him, but he took it
quite well. And made the
statement that he wanted
to talk to Apostle Kinsel
when he comes down in
August. After the lesson
he gave me a picture

that he had painted.
He had given Sister Balster
one before & I guess he
felt I had been neglected.

A while ago we heard
an interesting thing. The
Padre announced that
they are going to have
to start paying to
receive the sacrament. I
about died. I heard
& was shocked to find
out they had to pay
to be baptized, confirmed,
married, & buried but
the sacrament was real
bad. I wrote to Stor &
asked him if he didn't
think that wasn't putting
Christ up for sale. I
haven't heard from him
yet, but I anxious to
see what he says.

Sept 13, 1966.

Well, here I am trying to catch up again. So much has been happening. Sister Betsie has been making preparations to leave. We've been going all day every day. She and Sister Brown finally left day before yesterday. The Sister district is being dissolved. Sister Turnbow and I are now in Bosque, Ward 2.

Sister Bywaters & Sister Erickson are in Braggvile. Sister Leonard & Sister Thompson will stop in Santo Amaro.

Sister Turnbow is a real cute girl. We were hoping so hard that we could be sent together. She's been down 5 months longer than I have. So we're having a lot of fun leaving things

together. We are now
living with a real white
lady. Our room is not
large but we managed
to get all our junk moved
in. We'll each be starting
completely from scratch
as far as the area is
concerned. The Elders
who were here before
left us absolutely nothing.
We got back with one
of the Iron's so every-
thing is working out
beautifully.

Oh, Apostle Kimball
when he was here said
St. George's Apostles
would have to go before
the 1st Presidency. When
we told him he said
Oh, you don't let just
any old neophyte in
heal?

Sept 20, 1966

Yesterday was Branson
Day & Lester Burnham &
I went to the M-O. &
down town to see Dr.

Ziegler. While in the
M-O. we picked the
Improv Era & the
Relief Society Day.

All the way down town
& during lunch after
the show, home and
until 10:00 we talked
about President McKay
& the gospel. I feel
is good after the end
of the day. It's good
to talk about the things
that make you happy.

I hope we can always
do that and feel as
close as we did last
yesterday. This morning
we made arrangements

with a couple of
the Irmas. It's really
cloudy & rainy today.

Oh, last night we
went over to see
Marlene & Gilberte.

He has finally quit
smoking & he wants
to write to his Babs ter

They still can't decide
when to be baptized.

They say miss they're
going to but won't
pin down. So different
from Dr. Grady who
wants to be so bad
but can't till we
get an O.K.

Nov. 29, 1966

In awfuly lot has happened
since I wrote last. For
one thing Sr. Francy can't
be Baptized. Brother Spencer
W. Kirkall took it to the
first presidency & that
was their decision. It
seems like Sister J. & I
were meant to be in
Bosque. All we've done
just about is teach
young single girls.
We taught Bishop
Concepcion's maid & that
was my baptism. We
taught another girl
Celia Chiboni which was
credited to Sis. Gunther.
October 10th I became
officially engaged for
the 1st time. See the
fellow I've gone
with & his name

Oct 29, 1966

I was engaged to one
of them. I went down
& bought myself an
engagement ring like
the Brazilians use. They
use just a gold band.
When you're engaged
it goes on the right
hand & when you
marry you transfer
the wedding ring to the
left hand. I didn't
feel like putting out
\$10.00 for one so I buy
them in the Feira
for 800 cruzeiros. I
bought one last Oct. but
had to buy another one
the other day. The first
one started to peel.
My mother hasn't quite
accepted the fact yet
but -

Now that I'm understanding
the language better I'm
enjoying it a lot more.
I still feel out in
a sweet section I have
to give a bad lesson
but not as bad as
I did. But the language
is a lot funner than it
was.

Two new sisters come
down last Thursday's
Sister Leavitt & Sister
Thompson left yesterday.
The 2 new sisters will
work with Sister Baywater
& Sister Carlson. Two
more are coming in 2
weeks & Sister Durbin
& I get those.

The weather the past
week has been just
beautiful.

We're also teaching the
Relief Society Ward.

She's a real cute girl
but pretty ~~handsome~~. Oh
well, if the Holy Ghost
does for her what it
did for Bp. Comings
~~maid~~ it won't be

long till she's in the
swing of things. Teaching
would be more perfect
or more beautiful than
the Church of Jesus Christ
of Latter-day Saints.
How grateful I am to
be a member.

Sister Gunbow & I
get along just fine.
She is the sweetest girl!
We thought we were
going to be separated
~~the first~~ last week

unless the ^{new} Sisters come
down, but we didn't.

We were moping around
like a couple of sick
cats. We've had such
a good time together.

Nov. 30. th.

Well, another month has
disappeared. Today we
had a pep-up conference.
They're trying real hard
to set up group meetings.
Sis Gustow & I hasn't
done it as yet, but we
come right home & have
done a lot of planning. I
think our main problem
is getting out of the old
bed at 6:00. We're both
kinda leagy.

On my weight I
hit my see time high
of 142 lbs. That's a

gain of 24 lbs since
I left my horse on
January 24, 1966. Such
an eternity ago. The
past course of weeks,
however, I've been
losing. I'm about 135
now & would like to
stay there. Now I'm
35", 35", 37".

Tonight we going to the
Comix Family Night-
later.

Well in the way of a
family night it didn't
amount to much as it
was "free night." We
went to the automobile
show. It was pretty
good and a lot of fun.

When Sister Turnbow & I
first arrived here we
saw a Feira (Street Market)
& Sister Turnbow said, "oh,
this looks like a little
one." Well, we started
walking & gradually
began to realize that
it was probably the
biggest one in São Paulo.
Now we first call it
the "little Feira". I'm
sure that means nothing
to anyone reading this but
it's "ours" joke.

I know it quite figured
out why there is trouble
between Elders & Sisters. We
work with the best kind
of Elders. All you have
to do is feed them &
they think you're just
the greatest. One night

when we first come here
we made a huge邦加拉
dinner for them. Last
week we had them over
for strawberry shortcake &
icecream. They just think
we're the greatest!

December 6, 1966

Today has been one of the
hottest days I've ever
spent in Brazil - in
my life. But this afternoon
it's raining so that
kinda cooled things off.

Elder Glieber who is D.L.
in Ipiranga said that Elder
Kriskein over D.L. & the Z.C.
spent the first 15 minutes
of ~~that~~ ^{that} Mdg. telling them
what neat festes he had
& about the strawberry Shortcake
& how good it was.

December 15,

Today terminated sis
Turbo & my's time
together. We've been
companions for 3 months
to the day and I'm
sure there's never
been 2 companions
closer than we, two.
We've had so many
choice, funny experiences.
Yesterday we were
in our favorite bar
phonin' & a man
comes in with some
fatty & I think they
were crabs, on a
stair. I just gospel
in right & Sister
Turbo turned around
& let out a little
shriek. The bartender
told him to get them
out, that we were bombs

and aren't used to
such ugly things.

For the past couple
of days we've been
getting the new Sister
settled. I now have
my new comp & she's
a real nice girl. I
hated to end my
companionship with
Sister Turlock. She
has come to mean so
much to me. She's
going to work on the
other side of the city
in Fontana. They
are still a bronx
set there. I hope she
likes everything okay.

She's been so sad
all day & when we
went to the M.O. she
talked to Sister Dick

& had big tears in her
eyes. His Heibn was
laughing like crazy
trying to cheer ~~her~~ her
up.

My new companion
is from Eugene, Oregon.
She's 21 & her name
is Leonore Jaeger. I
like her a real lot
already & of the 2 that
come down I'm glad
she's mine. For some
reason she makes me
feel my age I guess
because she's kinda
my responsibility.
Waiting for them at the airport
was terrible. We just clung to
each other. We have been
so happy together & the time
went by too fast!

Dec. 29
1966

I'm so far behind I
don't see how we'll ever
be able to do justice to
all that has happened.

Dec 20 we caught
the neatest family. Oh,
how wonderful they'd
be in the church. They
have six children &
they seem to make a
flock over us. The
mother is Katie the
children Sonja 17
Sergio 16 Socha 14
Suey 13 Silvia 10
& Silvia Jr. The mother
is Arab & the Father
Spanish. They really
are neat to us. We're
going again next Tues.
We saw Dr. Fernandes
& his wife. They live on
the same street & they're

going to go visit them
That will really help
them out a lot!

Dec. the 24th we went
into the M-O. for the
Christmas Program. It
was so spiritual. I
loved this Christmas. All
the way around it was
perfect! I represented
the Sisters & sang "O
Holy Night". It's been
a long time since I
sang that. After the
Program we had refresh-
ments & sat around &
sang with the guitar.

Christmas Day we
had dinner with Bp
Coronado & his wife &
family. That night
after church - oh - the
Choir song & the

last number we sang
was Silent Night. I
sang the descant. One
of the dear Jesus
come late & didn't
know I was gonna
do it. When I
started she tried
to follow me. She
finally caught on
but the first couple
of lines were pretty
bad.

After that we had the
Elders plus Elder & brother
& his companion & sister
Gusbow & Sister Davis
come over. We had made
a tree out of tissue paper
(white) with ~~wishes~~
& the nativity & a Cornel
on it. It was so
much fun. Then we

decided to make 3
cuisines that we'd
seen in a Christmas
Idea Book. They turned
out just adorable. We
made salada de fruta
& Elder Fletcher brought
over 2 pies. We bought
each of the Elders a
little 50% gift. All
in all it was a
real fun party.

We know on Elder
is our district now
that hates women and
he makes no bones
about it. Sie decided
to make it a project to
get him to change his
mind. After we'd eaten
& the Elders opened their
presents he turned to
Elder Burton & said,

Iie got something to write
home this week. I lie
been converted - women
aren't so bad. Later
when we were singing
a song "Hey Lidie Lidie
Low" there were made
up verses spontaneously
he made up one on
how he liked the sisters.
I about died. Later we
were talking about going
home & getting married
& he said, not me. I
said, Elder Hamilton,
if a girl likes you when
you get home I'll give
you one month. He
didn't really argue. He
made the comment, if
he could get one to go
with him. He's got
a terrible inferiority

completely. Obviously.

Dec. 30.

This afternoon we gave
a first lesson to a
young girl. We had
a real struggle con-
vincing her that she
shouldn't pray to saints
but to God. We told
her about the Restoration
& I challenged her to
pray to God tonight to
ask for the right answer.

I hope she asks sincerely
& God understands my
lack of help for her &
really touches her heart.
She was a cute girl.

She said she'd decide
what to do & come to
church sometime & tell us.

After we went over to
Bro. & his Hooker (from
the states) & had dinner
with them. Real fun.

I even had a Pepsi Cola.
Oh, how good it was. It's
been along time.

The other night we
were on our way home
from the M.O. & we
met post Mary &
Maria's house. The
light was on. I know
it's against rules, but
I just had to wish
them Merry Christmas.

They were so thrilled to
see us. And had the very
day before walked around

for 3 hours in Bogota
looking for us. They gave
me a cute little glass
set. Oh how I love them

and how glad I was to
see them. I wish they'd
get baptized. Sister Balster
& I found them while
tractoring & we became
friends immediately.
They're a darling family.
Their boy Morris
Lentzson 20 I think
has a crush on me.
He went into the service
& sent me a card. I
didn't answer it. I feel
almost guilty.

Jan. 27.

Already January is almost gone. I just can't seem to keep caught up.

Ira & wife & family don't seem to be coming along to well. We've about decided to drop them. They really like us, but don't seem to feel any thing for Mormonism.

Saturday the 24th of January we were tracting & a young man opened the door & said, Come in, I'd like to hear about your church. We gave him the first lesson & invited he & his wife to Church.

They come. He's a young man. They're only been married little over a

year & have a new
baby. Last Sunday we
had dinner with them
& gave him the second
lesson. And they were
to church that night.

Last night we taught
a couple that we had
marked with before.
But when we went by
no one was home. Then
a couple of weeks a
refusal card came in
in them. They had
attended the 4th lesson.
They responded real well
to the questions & even
answered a couple of
the questions that I
seldom heard answered
correctly. They really
are sharp. Their names
are Jose & Elza Gonzalati

This afternoon I'm going to the Dr. again about my infection. I swear, if that doesn't clear up I'll go nuts. Well, I saw the Dr & it cost me \$10.00 just to have him tell me to go to the hospital & have a culture taken. I'm a wreck.

Tonight we went over to give ~~Jessie~~ Nelson & Gregoria the 4th but ended up eating dinner instead & it got too late. So we're going back tomorrow. They're so neat. We just really enjoy them.

If it weren't for the meat people we meet, I'd want to die.

Oh, I'm taking guitar lessons. It's a joke, I never have time to practice. At \$1.00 a crack I'd better learn, however.

January 30,

obviously busy. I
was extremely tired

this afternoon. He said
from the test that I

through Hollingshead!!

Tonight we taught
Albion & Jerry by the
5th lesson. Oh, what a
beautiful lesson.

Sister Young gave it
& did a beautiful job.
She will give the 1st
etc, but she gives a
beautiful lesson 5th.

tonight at 11:30
after we had gone
to bed. There was a
knock on the window.
It was Elders again.
We let them in &
they had looked awful.
Elder Fletcher had
been crying. I didn't
first see they had
spilled the coffee & more
the ladies were ready
but the men were
halfway. Elder Fletcher
was so upset. He
said the men were
just "Chick" with the
coffee. I felt so bad
for them. They asked
us to go over again
this afternoon & talk
to them. When they
left. Elder Fletcher

Knelt & He prayed.

you are to be a
missionary.

she was made a Ward
Missionary. She was
anxious for us to make
a first lesson & let her
give it. — After morning
session we all went
down & had lunch (the song)

back picked up Maria
& went to conference.
She still hasn't heard
from her folks about

being able to be Baptized
He is going to the interior
the end of May. After the
evening session of Conf.
we took Nelson & Dr.

night. While we were
talking to them I we
mentioned that I maybe
getting transferred soon.
They really got upset.
Wilson said he was
going to speak to the
President more as he
now knew him
personally. He was
asking me also about
Hall Missionary work.
We told him he had to
be an Elder. I told
him he was a baby
in the Church yet. He
said, "I feel I'm
Palerera Preacher than
English." I said, "you

"I am going to grow."

With the meeting with the
Bonnats went real well.
We gave them the 2nd & 3rd
and Nelson gave the the W&W,
