

July, 26,

All in all the program was real good

I thought Susan Beck
played a piano solo &
about 4 of the Elders put
on a skit on a gross and
mistake the Elders make
it really was cute.
Two of the Elders were the
husband & wife & the
other 2 were new
missionaries. Elder
Litchford looks is about
10'6" dressed up like
the wife, using Sister
Balslev's skirt & sweater
& a bonnet worn
like the Brethren wear
them & we put ~~on~~
my hairpiece on him.
All in all he looked
quite lovely. I saw of
the Elders sang in a
quartet. They sang
"Up Valley River" & "Bury

River." It was just beautiful. Then Sister Dalster concluded the Program with a dramatic reading on our Pioneer Heritage.

It was very dramatic & done very well. She had worked hard on it & spent a hectic day Sat. morning & afternoon making a Pioneer costume.

July 25, 1966

Today was the conference with President Lickers.

I think it was one of the most inspiring days I've spent since I left the Mission Home in fact Lickers after the conference which lasted 7:00 p.m. we gave

July 26,
Today first thing we
got up went to the M.O.
to talk to President Nicks
about Sr. Gray. The
President said we just
werent in a position to
forgive him of the murder
he had committed & if he
entered into the waters
of baptism that is what
we would be doing.
Sister Balster was pretty
upset about the prospect of
telling him, but he took it
quite well. And made the
statement that he wanted
to talk to Apostle Kimball
when he comes down in
August. After the lesson
he gave me a picture

that he had painted.
He had given Sister Balster
one before & I guess he
felt I had been neglected.

A while ago we heard
an interesting thing. The
Padre announced that
they are going to have
to start paying to
renew the sacrament. I
about died. I heard
& was shocked to find
out they had to pay
to be baptized, confirmed,
married, & buried but
the sacrament was real
had. I wrote to Ston &
asked him if he didn't
think that was not putting
Christ up for sale. I
haven't heard from him
yet, but I am anxious to
see what he says.

Sept 17, 1966.

Well, here I am trying to catch up again. So much has been happening. Sister Bishu has been making preparations to leave. We've been going all day every day. The end Sister Brown finally left day before yesterday. The Sister district is being dissolved. Sister Turnbow and I are now in Bosque, Ward 2. Sister Bywater & Sister Erickson are in Marquara. Sister Bennett & Sister Thompson will stay in Santo Amaro. Sister Turnbow is a real cute girl. We were hoping so hard that we could be put together. She's been down 5 months longer than I have. So we're having a lot of fun learning things

We had to buy things. We had so much fun buying things. We tried to buy some nice dresses with our Honda & demonstrator. It was funny.

together. We are now living with a real cute lady. Our room is real small but we managed to get all our junk moved in. We'll look be starting completely from scratch so far as the area is concerned. The Elders who were here before left us absolutely nothing. We sat lunch with one of the Irma's so everything is working out beautifully.

Oh, Apostle Kimball when he was here said N. Grant's Captain would have to go before the 1st Presidency. When we told him he said Oh, you don't let just any old magabondo in here?

Sept 20, 1966

Yesterday was Anniversary Day & Sister Durnshaw & I went to the M.O. & downtown to see Dr. Yivogzo. While in the M.O. we picked the Improv. Gra & the Relief Society Mag.

All the way downtown & during lunch after the show, home and until 10:00 we talked about President McKay & the Gospel. I felt so good after the end of the day. It's good to talk about the things that make you happy.

I hope we can always do that and feel as close as we did last yesterday. This morning we made acquaintance

with a couple of
the Irons. It's really
cloudy & raining today.
Oh, last night we
went over to see
Marlene & Gilbert.
He has finally quit
smoking & he wants
to see to his Balster
They still can't decide
whether to be baptized.
They say yes they're
going to but won't
pin down so different
from Mr. Irons who
wants to be so bad
but can't tell me
get an O.K.

Nov. 29, 1966

Sun. 9 Oct. 1966

An awfully lot has happened since I wrote last. For one thing Sr. Franny can't be baptized. Brother James W. Kimball took it to the first presidency & that was their decision. It seems like Sister G. & I were meant to be in Bosque. All we've done just about is teach young single girls. We taught Bishop Comarzo's maid & that was my baptism. We taught another girl Celine Chiboni which was credit to his baptism.

October 10th I became officially engaged for the 1st time. See the fellows I'm going with & I'm never

been engaged to one
of them. I went down
& bought myself an
engagement ring like
the Brazilians use. They
use just a gold band.
When you're engaged
it goes on the right
hand & when you
marry you transfer
the same ring to the
left hand. I didn't
feel like putting out
\$0.00 for one so I buy
them in the Feira
for 800 Cruzeiros. I
bought one in Oct but
had to buy another one
the other day. The first
one started to peel.
My mother hasn't quite
accepted the fact yet
but -

Now that I'm understanding
the language better I'm
enjoying it a lot more.
I still break out in
a sweat when I have
to give a ~~1st~~ lesson
but not as bad as
I did. But the language
is a lot finer than it
was.

Two new sisters come
down last Thursday &
Sister Bennett & Sister
Thompson left yesterday.
The 2 new sisters will
work with Sister Beywater
& Sister Erickson. Two
more are coming in 2
weeks & Sister Durbin
& I get those.

The weather the past
week has been just
beautiful.

We're also teaching the
Relief Societies Ward.

She's a real cute thing
but pretty hoarse. Oh
well, if the Holy Ghost
does for her what it
did for Bro. Comings's
maid it won't be
long till she's in the
swing of things. Nothing
could be more perfect
or more beautiful than
the Church of Jesus Christ
of Latter-day Saints.
How grateful I am to
be a member.

Sister Turnbow & I
get along just fine.
She is the sweetest girl!
We thought we were
going to be separated
~~the~~ just last week

when the ^{new} sisters come
down, but we weren't.
We were moping around
like a couple of sick
cats. We've had such
a good time together.

Nov. 30th.

Well, another month has
disappeared. Today we
had a pep-up conference.
They're trying real hard
to set up group meetings.
Sis Gustaf & I haven't
done it as yet, but we
come right home & have
done alot of planning. I
think our main problem
is getting out of the old
bed at 6:00. We're both
kinda lazy.

On my weight I
hit my all time high
of 142 lbs. That's a

gain of 24 lbs since
I left my home on
January 24, 1966. Such
an eternity ago. The
past couple of weeks,
however, I've been
losing. I'm about 135
now & would like to
stay there. Now I'm
35", 25", 37".

Tonight we're going to the
Comary Family Night-
Later.

Well in the way of a
family night it didn't
amount to much as it
was "free night." We
went to the Automobile
Show. It was pretty
good and a lot of fun.

When Sister Turnbow & I first arrived here we saw a Feira (Street Market) & Sister Turnbow said, "Oh, this looks like a little one." Well, we started walking & gradually began to realize that it was probably the biggest one in São Paulo. Now we just call it the "Little Feira". I'm sure that means nothing to anyone reading this but it's "our" joke.

I haven't quite figured out why there is trouble between Elders & Sisters. We work with the best bunch of Elders. All you have to do is feed them & they think you're just the greatest. One night

when we first come here
we made a huge Buzonha
dinner for them. Last
week we had them over
for Strawberry Shortcake &
ice cream. They just think
we're the greatest!

December 4, 1966

Today has been one of the
hottest days I've ever
spent in Brazil - in
my life. But this afternoon
it's raining so that
Linda cooled things off.

Elder Fletcher who is D-L
in Ipironopolis said that Elder
Krisken our D-L & the 2C
spent the first 15 minutes
of ~~their~~ ^{their} msg. telling them
what neat sisters he had
& about the Strawberry Shortcake
& how good it was.

December 15,

Today commemorated Jim's
Turbow & my's time
together, We've been
companions for 3 months
to the day and I'm
sure there's never
been 2 companions
closer than we have.
We've had so many
choice, funny experiences.
Yesterday we were
in our favorite bar
phoning & a man
came in with some
furry & I think they
were crabs, on a
string. I just gasped
in fright & Sister
Turbow turned around
& let out a little
shriek. The bartender
told him to get them
out, that we were boys

and weren't used to
such ugly things.

For the past couple
of days we've been
getting the new babies
settled. I now have
my new comp & she's
a real nice girl. I
hated to end my
companionship with
Sister Justine. She
has come to mean so
much to me. She's
going to work on the
other side of the city
in Fortuna. They
are still a bunch
out there. I hope she
likes everything okay.

She's been so good
all day & when we
went to the M.O. she
talked to Sister Justine

I had big tears in her eyes. His. Heibn was taking like crazy trying to cheer ~~us~~ us up.

My new companion is from Eugene, Oregon she's 21 & her name is Leonora Jauzy. I like her a real lot already & of the 2 that come down I'm glad she's mine. For some reason she makes me feel my age I guess because she's sorta my responsibility.

Waiting for them at the airport was horrible. We just cling to each other. We have been so happy together & the time went by so fast!

Dec. 29
1966

I'm so far behind I don't see how I'll ever be able to do justice to all that has happened.

Dec. 20 we taught the neatest family. Oh, how wonderful they'd be in the Church. They have six children & they sure do make a guess over us. The mother is Katin the children Jordra 17 Sergio 16 Joshua 14 Suely 13 Silvio 10 & Silvia 8. The mother is Arab & the father Spanish. They really are neat to us. We're going again next Tues. We saw Dr. Ferrando & his wife. They live on the same street & they're

going to go visit them
That will really help
them out alot!

Dec. the 20th we went
into the M.O. for the
Christmas Program. It
was so spiritual. I
loved this Christmas. All
the way around it was
perfect! I represented
the Sisters & sang "O
Holy Night". It's been
a long time since I
sang that. After the
Program we had refresh-
ments & sat around &
sang with the guitar.

Christmas Day we
had dinner with Bp
Conroy & his wife &
family. That night
after church - oh - the
Choir song & the

last number we sang
was Silent Night. I
sang the descent. One
of the dear Irmas
came late & didn't
know I was gonna
do it. When I
started she tried
to follow me. She
finally caught on
but the first couple
of lines were pretty
bad.

After that we had the
Elders plus Elder Gitcher
& his companion & Sister
Sunbow & Sister David
come over. We had made
a tree out of tissue paper
(white) with wisemen
& the nativity & a Camel
on it. It was so
much fun. Then we

decided to make 3
revisions that we'd
seen in a Christmas
Idea book. They turned
out just adorable. We
made Salada de fruta
& Elder Fitcher brought
over 2 pies. We bought
each of the Elders a
little 50¢ gift. All
in all it was a
real fun party.

We know our Elder
is our District now
that hates women. And
he makes no bones
about it. I've decided
to make it a project to
get him to change his
mind. After we'd eaten
& the Elders opened their
presents, he turned to
Elder Gorton & said,

I've got something to write
home this week. I've
been converted - women
aren't so bad. Later
when we were singing
a song "Hey Liddy Liddy
Low" when you make
up verses spontaneously
he made up one on
how he liked the sisters.
I almost died. Later we
were talking about going
home & getting married
& he said, not me. I
said, Elder Hamilton
if a girl likes you when
you get home I'll give
you one month. He
didn't really argue. He
made the comment, if
he could get one to go
with him. He's got
a horrible inferiority

comply. Obviously.

Dec. 30.

This afternoon we gave a first lesson to a young girl. We had a real struggle convincing her that she shouldn't pray to saints but to God. We told her about the Resurrection & I challenged her to pray to God tonight to ask for the right answer. I hope she asks sincerely & God understands my lack of help for her & really touches her heart. She was a cute girl. She said she'd decide what to do & come to Church sometime & tell us.

After we went over to
Bro. & Sis Hornblin (from
the states) & had dinner
with them. Real fun.
I even had a Pepsi Cola.
Oh, how good it was. It's
been along time.

The other night we
were on our way home
from the M.O. & we
went past Mary &
Maria's house. The
light was on. I know
it's against rules, but
I just had to wish
them Merry Christmas.
They were so thrilled to
see us. And had the very
day before walked around
for 3 hours in Bosque
looking for us. They gave
me a cute little glass
set. Oh how I love them

and how glad I was to
see them. I wish they'd
get baptized. Sister Bolster
& I found them while
travelling & we became
friends immediately.
They're a darling family.
Their boy Marcus
Antoine 20 I think
has a crush on me.
He went into the service
& sent me a card. I
didn't answer it. I feel
almost guilty.

Jan. 27.

Already January is almost gone. I just can't seem to keep caught up.

Irma Kates & family don't seem to be coming along so well. We're about decided to drop them. They really like us, but don't seem to feel any thing for Mormonism.

Saturday the 14th of January we were visiting a young man opened the door & said, Come in, I'd like to hear about your church. We gave him the first lesson & invited he & his wife to Church.

They come. He's a young man. They're only been married little over a

year & have a new
baby. Last Sunday we
had dinner with them
& gave him the second
lesson. And they were
to church that night.

Last night we taught
a couple that we had
marked with before
but when we went by
no one was home. This
a couple of weeks a
referral card came in
on them. They had
attended the 4th lesson.
They responded real well
to the questions & even
answered a couple of
the questions that I've
seldom heard answered
correctly. They really
are sharp. Their names
are João & Elza Bonzallati

This afternoon I'm going to the Dr. again about my infection. I swear, if that doesn't clear up I'll go nuts. Well, I saw the Dr. & it cost me \$10.00 just to have him tell me to go to the hospital & have a culture taken. I'm a wreck.

Tonight we went over to give ~~John~~ Nelson & Arjula the 4th but ended up eating dinner instead & it got too late. So we're going back tomorrow. They're so neat. We just really enjoy them. If it weren't for the neat people we meet, I'd want to be

home, messes. When you
go downtown + see all
the poverty + heaves you
just wanna get away
from it all. At least
I do.

Oh, I'm taking guitar
lessons. It's a joke, I
never have time to
practice. At \$1.00 a
crack I'd better learn,
however.

I just might try
to faithfully keep up
with this diary. I
do enjoy writing but
so much seems routine.

Last night my comp
& I made a 5 month
anniversary card for Alton.
Hope he likes it. I wrote
a poem - less you
wonder what I'm getting
into.

Jan 28, 67.

Well, we've gone. Nelson
and his wife the 27th.

They really seem to be
accepting the Gospel well.
We were talking about
the authenticity of the
B of M. from the Bible's
point of view & we
showed him a few
scriptures. He was
really impressed. Said
there was a man at
work that would do
Mormonism & he wanted
to make the scriptures
& show them to him.

I went to the hospital
this morning. They took
a culture test. I sure
hope they find what
they're looking for. A
year or so ago I was
told to be fed up.

with an infection.

January 30,
Well, today was
Division Day. I
was extremely bored
all day. I met the
new sisters that just
come down. My, they're
tall. Sure. I'll quit
complaining. We went
to a Chinese Restaurant
for lunch then to the
Sound of Music again.
That movie really is
terrific. I sure hope
my Fair Lady comes
again. After we come
home we went to Irma
Jacobs's for dinner.
They really are a cute
family. They're making me
a couple of dresses.

Jan 31,

This morning a funny thing happened. I hardly ~~at~~ said, "Now Gather in Heaven" (in my prayer) than my conscience started in on me & just ripped me up one side & down the other. It also proceeded to tell me that I had to, by April 21, know my 200 scriptures, all the lessons well, have read all the standard works in Portuguese & learn 20 new words a day. The real problem came when he said the whole New Testament by the end of this week. I'm only at Matt. 19. In

This morning we
combined the 1st & 2nd
for a teacher of one
of the members that
wants to be baptized.
She's going to be baptized
Sunday along with
another little girl we
taught.

Sunday one of the
members' maids came
up to us & said she

We were just on
our way to Sr.

it started to sprinkle,

minutes it was pouring.
We honked & covered a
few but still got

soaked. Jim really

Testament I read half
of Matt & all of Luke.
We went over to Irma
Nair's & talked to her
for a minute this
afternoon. A Marquette
Work & Wonder is out.
It looks so neat. We
hurried down to the
Centro Editorial but
even too late they were

Feb. 1, 1967.

This afternoon the Elders
(Fletcher & Pallen) from
Vila Mariana, come
over & said they had

her the 4th lesson as
she had missed it.
We did and all
seemed to go real well.

Feb. 2,
Today we had a
Missionary Conference.
Well, a Zone Conference.
But it was great. I
don't know how but
they just got better
all the time.

After a bunch of
us went to the
Pukayat for dinner.
Oh, it was good.

Feb. 3,
I went to the Dr.
this afternoon. He said
from the test that
I come back that I
had all kinds of
bugs. He gave me
a heap subscription
4 different types of
medicine. Well in
18 days I'm all
through. Hallelujah!!

Tonight we taught
Nelson & Jerry on the
5th lesson. Oh, that a
beautiful lesson.

Sister Young gave it
& did a beautiful job.
She can't give the 1st
yet, but she gives a
beautiful lesson 5th.

Dinner at 11:30
after we had gone
to bed. There was a
knock on the window.
It was Elden again.
We let them in &
they both looked awful.
Elden Fletcher had
been crying. Come to
find out they had
signed the 5th & moved
the signs were ready
but the men were
talking. Elden Fletcher
was so upset. He
said the men were
just "Chah" with the
5th. I felt so bad
for them. They asked
us to go over again
this afternoon & talk
to them. When they
left, Elden Fletcher

resorted to saying
Prayer so, we
knelt & he prayed.
I'm awfully worried
about my ability to
help. But if God
wonts them as much
as John apparently
does, we'll do ~~anything~~.

I've been reading
100 pages a day in
the New Testament.

really buckled down &
organized, I'm a lot
happier. The only time
I have to think of

These kind of experiences
& closeness makes you
realize how lucky
you are to be a
missionary.

We also found out
Monday that Nelson
has the lineage. I've
been so upset all
week I've been useless.
They are so excited

about the Church. And
already call it "our"
Church.

April 10,

I'm a bad girl.

A lot has happened!

Most of it I've written
home to mother.

Nelson & Irene
Penkins Machado were
baptized the 26th of
Feb. I sent the Elders
to their house to find
out for sure if they
had the bronze & they
didn't so we gave them
the 6th lesson the following
Saturday & also told them
about the lineage &
genealogy.

May 8, 1967

Catch up time again.

The 14th of April we checked out a sample of references and marked 2 visits with Anita & Pascual Bermenter & family.

The 19th (of April) we gave Anita the 1st. She took it rather well but seemed more interested than convinced. But she is a real sweet lady, we've marked to track her later.

The 20th we had a group meeting at Nelson & Jevishkin. It came out pretty well. I'm not sure that the one family doesn't have the lineage, but there was a young Jewish girl there that was really interested. I gave

her a marvelous work
& a wonder.

The 30th was Stake
Conference. All the M.I.A.
Youth sang. They did a
beautiful job & Missions
& Terijuku song. I saw
Ureara then & she &
her sister have moved
out to their own. I know
she was made a Ward
Missionary. She was
anxious for us to make
a first lesson & let her
give it. - After morning
session we all went
down & had lunch (the gang)
the Peter Garry & I came
back picked up Maria
& went to conference.
She still hasn't heard
from her folks about

being able to be baptized
he is going to the interior
the end of May. After the
evening session of conf.
we took Nelson & Jr.
up to meet President
Hickson. Nelson really
wanted to meet him.

May.
3rd Wed. We gave the Bannocks
the 1st. They really
took it quite well. They

They really got upset.

going to speak to the
President now as he
now knew him
personally. He was
asking me also about
State Mission work.
We told him he had to
be an Elder. I told
him he was a baby
in the Church yet. He
said, "I give I a
palovera crosser I'm
English. I said, grow.
He said (in English)
"I am going to grow."

both the meeting with the
Barnes went real well.
We gave them the 2nd & 4th
and Nelson gave the the W of W,
Footing, Tithing, Foot offerings,
Testimony Mtg. M.I.A. Family
night & family prayer. I
couldn't believe it. I
just sat in amazement!
He did invite them to
Foot & Testimony Mtg.
but they didn't show. It
rather upset me.

7th We had a beautiful
Testimony Mtg. Nelson was
~~set apart~~ ^{sustained} as to be adv.
in the Priesthood and bore
his testimony. And told of
his coming in contact with
the Church. How I love them

was excommunicated. Oh,

8th Today we had a
farewell dinner for Elder

chicken & dressing, mashed
potatoes & gravy, carrots

Burton found out today
that he's going to Jents

going Assistant. Most of
us 'the gang' knew
at last week but no

One wanted to tell Elder
Barton. This pretty blue

Elder Halbrook, E. Barton, Jim
Sunbow & I went in the
chapel & sang hymns. It
was really wonderful.
