



Dear Sister Ross:

We have been advised by the First Presidency of your call to serve in the Brazilian Mission. We commend you and look forward to meeting you upon your arrival at Mission Headquarters in São Paulo.

To assist you in your preparations and travel, we make the following suggestions and recommendations:

1. Study carefully the list of suggested items and general instructions furnished you by the First Presidency. It will answer most of your questions. 2. We recommend that you bring the book <u>Brazilian Portuguese Grammar</u> by Maria de Lourdes Sá Pereira. This book may be obtained at the Deseret Book Store. 3. Determine the status of your personal or family medical insurance if you have any. Although this matter is optional, most of these programs have no value outside the United States unless a special rider is arranged before you leave. In the event that you need medical care during your mission, such an arrangement could assist in the expense. We do not urge you to take out a new policy.

4. We request that you send four passport photos of yourself as soon as possible. We will be happy to answer any questions you may have. You should allow three weeks for an answer.

You will want to take full advantage of the program of the Language Training Mission. We expect that a few weeks after your arrival here you will have overcome much of the "language barrier" and will be able to devote yourself fully to the fascinating and uniquely rewarding experience of teaching the Gospel to a truly prepared people. In addition to the language, basic information on the history, geography and culture of Brazil will be of value to you.

You can expect to be met at the airport in Sao Paulo by myself or my representative and assisted through customs and conducted to the Mission Home. May the Lord bless you with the desire to learn more than you have ever learned before. We pray that you will have a pleasant journey.

Dear Sister Ross:

The members of the Brazilian Zone take great pleasure in welcoming you to the Language Training Mission. It is really a wonderful opportunity to be here. You will find the Training Mission to be a regularly organized mission of the Church, so please recognize the fact that this is not college life. Though you may not baptize anyone here, you will be working for our Father in Heaven and sharpening your tools for the harvest.

You will grow in many ways here. We hope you will open your mind and heart to receive the things awaiting you, and such will be the case if you only seek them. We know you will bring a great spirit with you and an overabundance of enthusiasm. If you keep this attitude and spirit, you will be a success.

As you know, you will study Portuguese here in preparation for preaching the Gospel in Brazil. You will be placed in the District of <u>BANDETRANTES</u> while you are here. Some may have higher capacities than others, but with the God-given gift of tongues, all will learn very rapidly.

Any missionary here will be more than glad to help you with any difficulty that you may encounter. We are all working in the Church together until we come to a unity of the faith. Helping each other and sharing ideas is one way to become more united. After your third day here, you will be expected to speak only "português," so be prepared to come and learn rapidly.

Please come with the idea in mind that you are in the mission field, because you are. Your friends, relatives and all others concerned should consider you as inaccessible as if you were already in Brazil. You will function much better if you set your eye on the road ahead and dedicate yourself completely to the work for the next two and onefourth years. Never turn back, because when you do, you cannot plow a straight furrow.

We will be looking forward to meeting you this coming Sunday.

We are grateful to you for Sister Ross, and we suggest a weekly correspondence with her in care of Caixa Postal 862, São Paulo, S.P., Brazil. Regular letters will assist in combating any adjustment problem or homesickness which may occur. Cheerful family news full of encouragement and with the positive spirit toward missionary work will exert a great influence for good on your missionary.

We discourage you from sending any type of package to your daughter, even at Christmastime. Many packages are lost, and those that get through are difficult and expensive to get out of customs. If you insist on sending a package, it must be addressed to the Brazilian Mission in care of me.


